

WE'VE ALREADY MADE A BIG START

It's in everyone's interest that we all stay as free from pollution and waste as possible. At Red Funnel we are totally committed to doing everything we can to protect our unique environment for residents and visitors alike – and we've already made a great start.

 Since 1996 the entire fleet has used 0.1% low sulphur fuel – the benefit to our communities of not pumping thousands of tonnes of sulphur into the atmosphere, is priceless.

We are now going a step further. Starting October 2018, Red Falcon will run on eco-friendly biofuel, significantly reducing Sulphur Dioxide, Nitrogen Dioxide and Carbon Dioxide exhaust emissions.

 In our terminals and on-board we have launched an anti-idling campaign to encourage and educate drivers to not leave their engines running whilst queuing. This campaign will improve air quality and deliver fuel savings for customers.

We are one of the first ferry companies in the world to offer drivers of pure electric cars and small vans a discount on new bookings as a thank you for their contribution to improving air quality.

 We are also planning to roll-out electric vehicle re-charging points at our terminals and car parks.

In our terminals we are already using some electric vehicles, and our new Quayconnect bus which arrives in autumn 2018 is Euro 6 compliant.

 On-board we've replaced all plastic plates, straws and cutlery with eco-friendly alternatives. Not only is it the right thing for the environment, but everything tastes better too! We are working on alternatives for milk and sauce sachets and other single-use plastics.

 We also recycle all of our used cooking oil, much of which goes to make eco-friendly biofuel.

We've also installed new energy efficient zero ozone depleting chillers on all our ships, which give a 65% reduction in global warming potential.

There are many more initiatives we are working on as part of our commitment to lower our carbon footprint. Some initiatives include the installation of LED lighting throughout the business, only using paper from sustainable sources, and encouraging our staff and regular travellers to cycle or car share.

 We are also recruiting environmental champions throughout our business, and we will continue to sponsor environmental projects such as the Isle of Wight's Biggest Ever Beach Clean.

 Red Funnel was one of the first ferry companies to be accredited with the environmental management system standard ISO 14001.


